The Advanced Research Collaborative (ARC) of The Graduate Center, CUNY, invites applicants to apply for the Distinguished CUNY Fellow Award for the 2021-2022 academic year.

This award is for scholars and researchers at the colleges of the City University of New York. The fellowship is tenable for one semester during the 2021-2022 academic year. Awardees will receive course buyouts up to a maximum of 3 course releases for that semester. All fellows will be provided an office, computer, and access to The Graduate Center's academic infrastructure.

Distinguished CUNY Fellows are expected to carry out their work regularly at The Graduate Center, and to participate in the intellectual and academic community of ARC and The Graduate Center. In practice, this means:

- Using their Graduate Center office on a regular basis
- Interacting regularly and sharing their work with other ARC events
- Presenting their research at one of the weekly seminars
- Attending the weekly seminars on Thursdays from 4:00-5:30 as well as other ARC events
