A Distinguished Visiting Scholar will receive an office, computer, and access to The Graduate Center's academic infrastructure. Depending on the duration of stay, travel costs to and from the fellowship can be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$3,000 for the most economical fare only and following the submission of the required documentation. No housing is provided as part of this fellowship.

Distinguished Visiting Scholars are expected to carry out their work regularly at The Graduate Center, and to participate in the intellectual and academic community of ARC and The Graduate Center. In practice, this means:

- Using their Graduate Center office on a regular basis
- Interacting regularly and sharing their work with other ARC fellows
- Presenting their research at one of the weekly seminars
- Attending the weekly seminars on Thursdays from 4:00-5:30 as well as other ARC events
