Description:

GMHC is the world's first and leading provider of HIV/AIDS prevention, care and advocacy. The organization offers inclusive services for men, women, families and youth, including HIV counseling, testing, health information, education, risk-reduction strategies, referrals and partner notification services. People who want to be tested must complete an intake and consent to testing. Referrals for additional supportive services are also available. Syphilis testing is also available. All services are free of charge.

The Testing Center will see clients twice a year (every 6 months) for HIV and STI testing services. Please allow 15-20 minutes to complete an intake form prior to being seen by a test counselor. The Testing Center is open Monday – Wednesday from 9:30 am – 4 pm for walk-ins, Thursday from 9:30 am – 4 pm for appointments only, and Friday from 12:30 pm – 7 pm for walk-ins.

Please note: Every Wednesday the testing center is closed from 1 pm to 2:30 pm. The Testing Center hours are 12:30 pm – 4 pm the second Friday of each month.

Description:

The Testing Services Department aims to identify and test at-risk populations in Upper Manhattan and the South Bronx for HIV, STIs and hepatitis C. The Testing Department offers both rapid testing and follow-up confirmatory tests for HIV. They have trained phlebotomists to draw blood for syphilis and hepatitis C screening. Gonorrhea and chlamydia are tested through urine-based screening. Testing is available Monday through Friday from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. Must return to the same location in one-to-two weeks for results. Cannot receive results over the phone!
