

**Moe and Hannah Bergman 2017 Scholarship Fund Awards
for GC Speech-Language-Hearing Sciences Student Conference Travel**

Dear Students and Faculty:

Professor Moe Bergman headed our doctoral program at the beginning of the CUNY Graduate Center, bringing it into being and locating numerous sources of funding for the earliest students. In 2006, our program held a day-long conference to honor his work heading up our program in its early years and his many research contributions to the field of Audiology.

The Moe and Hannah Bergman Scholarship Fund was set up at that time and began awarding funds for students traveling to present papers or posters they are first-authoring at conferences. These funds can be used to pay for conference registration, travel to the conference, and lodging at the conference. Students in our program can apply after they have submitted an abstract to a conference they plan to attend if it is accepted. **All abstracts submitted since last year's deadline will be considered for funding; i.e., abstracts submitted between April 20, 2016 and April 24, 2017 are eligible for awards.** We anticipate awarding 6 student awards of about \$200 per student this year. Upon returning from the conference (**or when awards are announced if students have already made the presentation in the past year**), students who have been granted awards must submit receipts covering the amount they have been awarded and the award will then be paid to them.

To apply, send Patricia Goodson your name, your submitted abstract, the conference name, dates, location, along with information on the conference registration fee and estimated travel and lodging costs. Write down whether your abstract was accepted. **Submission of materials is due April 24, 2017.** Announcement of awards will be made by May 17, 2017.
