1. Because of the small size of this doctoral faculty ~~(7)~~ the faculty, meeting as a committee of whole, will carry out executive committee functions, and no executive committee shall be constituted.
2. Two elected student representatives will participate in faculty meetings with full voting rights on all matters of policy. Specifically excepted shall be matters of faculty personnel; student awards; the construction and grading of student major examinations (Qualifying Paper - Qualifying Examination) and other matters designated administrative.
3. Faculty attendance at all faculty meetings shall be expected for the duration of appointment to the DSW Faculty.
4. Student representatives who attend faculty meetings will do so as a result of annual student elections.
5. The faculty committee of the whole with student representation shall deal with all functions of an Executive Committee as described in Section ~~4.6F~~ of the Graduate Council By Laws.
6. The faculty committee of the whole with student representation shall meet at least twice each semester. Additional meetings may be called by the Executive Officer or on the request of faculty or of student representative.
7. Faculty or student participants may request or submit items for the agenda of faculty meetings.
8. Vacancies in student representation shall be filled by special elections.
9. Amendments to these procedures may be made in accordance with the Graduate Council By Laws.
