

How Do I Connect To the GC Community Wireless Network Using Windows 10?

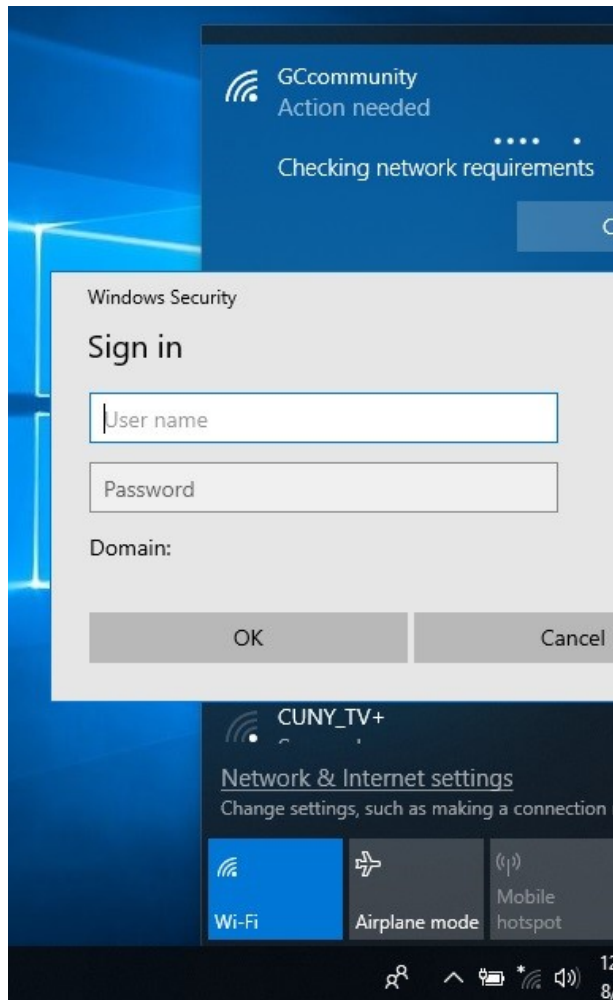

1. Click on your Wi-Fi icon to bring up the list of available networks.

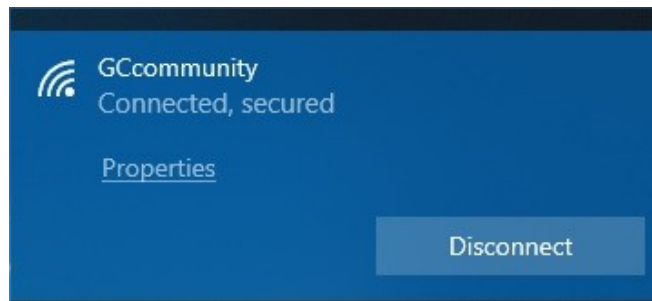


2. You will have the option to connect to **GCcommunity**, which is the secure network for students, faculty, and staff, or **GCguest**, which is for all non-GC users, but is less secure.

3. When you click on GCcommunity, a pop up will appear requiring your **GC network credentials**.



4. Once you enter your credentials and click on OK, the network will connect automatically.



5. If you connect using GCguest, a pop up window will appear with a TOS page. Enter an email address, and click on I accept using the mouse pointer.
- * Do not press enter on the keyboard as this will just reload the page.
