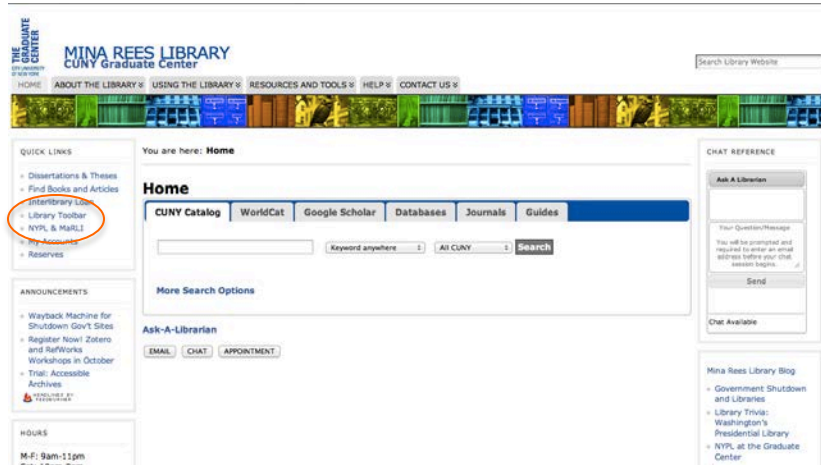


How to get MaRLI? Follow the instructions:

1. Go to <http://library.gc.cuny.edu/> (Mina Rees Library page) -On the Quick Links (left side menu from top), click on **NYPL & MaRLI**

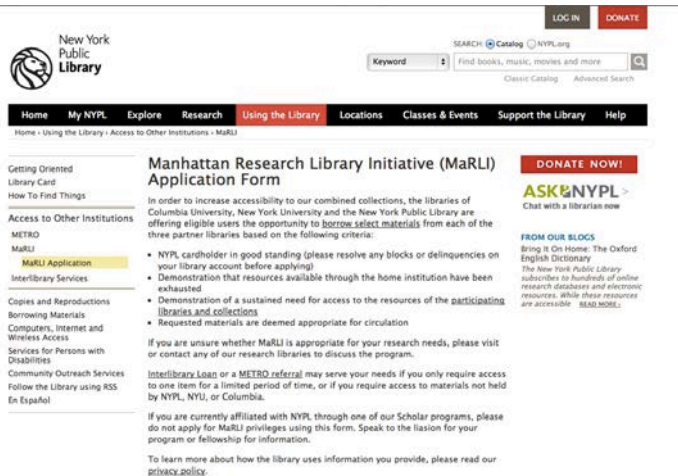
