

## DETAILS

- Children must be 6-12 years old with and without language difficulties.
- Spoken English must be the primary language used at home.
- Participants receive \$15 per hour for each session (usually \$30/session).
- Results of speech, language, and hearing tests will be available to you in a written report.



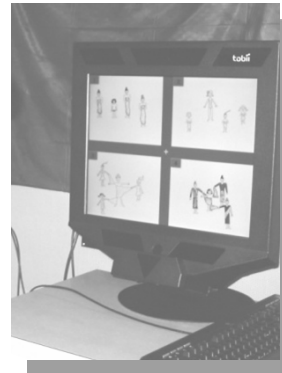

**How do children understand complex language?**  
**What does tracking eye movements tell us about how children organize words and use language?**

## WHAT IS INVOLVED?

- Hearing screening
- Standardized language tests assessing spoken as well as memory and processing



- Completion of standardized tests
- Picture or sound study asking your child to make verbal or keyboard responses
- Eye Tracking study asking your child to make judgments about what he/she heard

## TYPICAL SESSION

- 4:00 Arrive and meet clinician in the waiting room, sign consent forms, and discuss testing procedures
- 4:10 Conduct hearing screening and administer language tests to the child in a private clinic room
- 5:00 Break for a snack with parent in the waiting room
- 5:10 Continue testing
- 6:00 Complete testing and receive compensation
